FOUNDEREE AND FOUNDER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS

The Association has for many years marked the Founder's Day celebrations (every February) in Nyeri by the grave of the movement's Founder, an event usually attended by over 30,000 Scouts from across the country and beyond.

With the newly devolved KSA Constitutional framework, the Association wishes to inform the public, all Scouts and Scout Leaders that it has restructured the conduct of and participation at the Founder's Day Celebration and Founderee Camp in Nyeri during this and every year henceforth. The Founderee Celebrations will be held in the Counties to give more Scouts the opportunity to participate, reduce travelling expenses and the risk of travelling all the way to Nyeri for the celebrations.

The Association's National Youth Program Committee will invite representative teams from the county to participate in the **National/International Founder's Day celebrations to be held on 21st February, 2016 at the BP Park in Nyeri County.**

Kindly note that only invited teams will be hosted in Nyeri and all other Scouts are encouraged to take part in the Founder's Day Celebrations in their respective counties.
