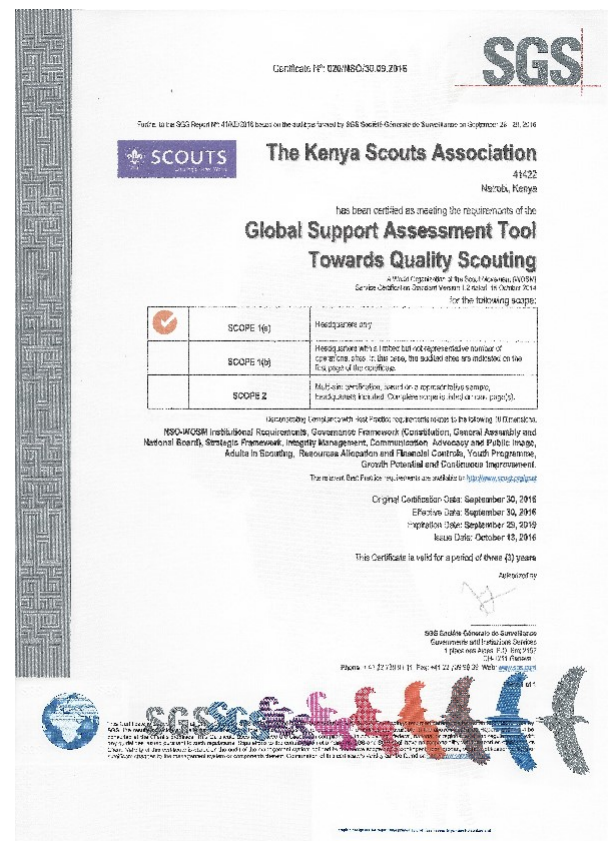
## The Kenya Scouts Association Gets SGS Certification



The Kenya Scouts Association has been awarded SGS Certification after attaining a Score of 90.2% in a SGS Audit which took place on 28<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2016, at the Associations Headquarters, Rowallan National Scouts Camp Nairobi.

SGS is an International Service Certification Standard aimed at Assessing the Accountability of Organizations/National Scout Organizations (NSOs) and Serve as a reference of Best Practices for the NSOs.

The Association has a membership of over 1.3 Million boy and girl Scouts with a total of 40,000 Scout Leaders.



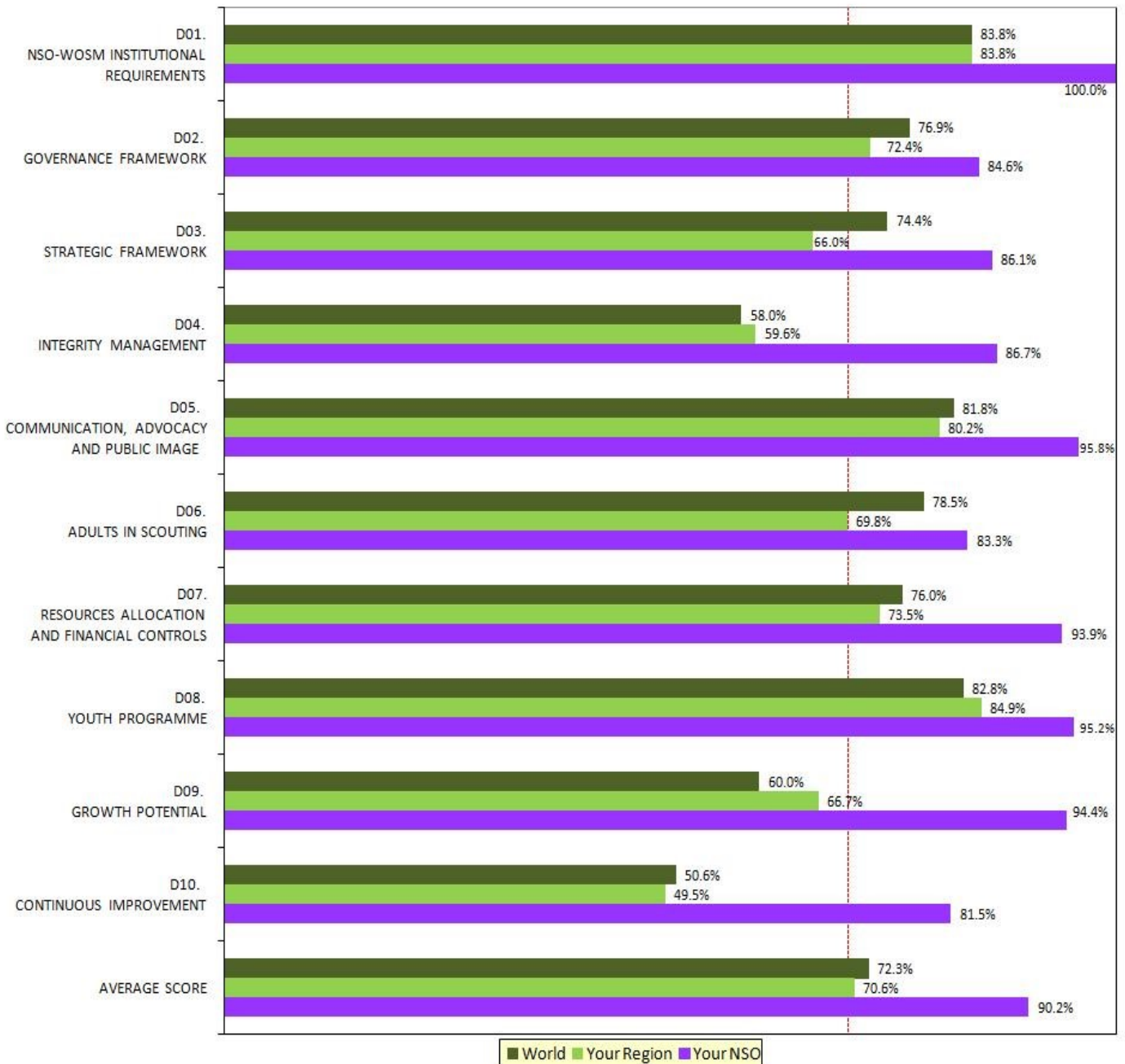

AVE	72.3%	70.6%	90.2%



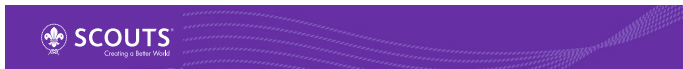
